Held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the NCRs of the Confederation of Australian Motorsport Ltd. (CAMS), the Speed Event Standing Regulations of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, the 2014 Club Hillclimb Standing Regulations, the CAMS Passenger in Vehicle Guidelines, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations and bulletins that may be issued. This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au. Insurance for this event will be provided in accordance with Appendix I of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

1. EVENT STANDING

The event is a Multi-Club Hillclimb and forms part of the Collingrove Challenge Trophy Series. The Hillclimb is a bitumen sealed surface course, approximately 685 metres long and 3.3 metres wide.

3. COMPETITORS

Must be financial members of the Sporting Car Club of SA Inc. (SCCSA) or a CAMS affiliated club.

Competitors must hold as a minimum, a current CAMS Level 2S/2SJ Licence. Competitors are referred to Item 3 of the 2014 Club Hillclimb Series Regulations in regards to licence requirements, and advised that non production of relevant documentation may entail forfeiture of entry fee and permission to compete may be withdrawn.

To be eligible for an award, competitors are referred to Item 13b of the 2014 Club Hillclimb Series Regulations.

4. ENTRIES

Entries open with the publication of these Supplementary Regulations. Entries must be made using www.meecamsau.com or on the prescribed form and sent with payment to the Events Manager, Sporting Car Club of South Australia, 51 King William Road, Unley. FAX (08) 8373 4703.

All entries received at the Sporting Car Club before the closing date of **4:00pm** on **Wednesday the 15th October 2014** will pay an entry fee of **\$90.00** for SCC Club Members, or **\$110.00** for Non SCC Members. Please note all Entry Fees are GST inclusive.

not be refundable except:

- a. In case of the abandonment of the meeting.
- b. Where the entry is withdrawn by written advice to the Secretary of the Meeting by the fifth day prior to the event/meeting.
- c. Where an entry is refused.

Entries will be limited to 120 and shall be accepted in order of receipt. **No late entries will be accepted.** Entries may be refused in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

The following multiple entries are permitted – two drivers / one vehicle – two vehicles / one driver. **These entries must be on separate forms with each being subject to individual entry fee.**

6. PRACTICE

There will be no practice for this event. **All runs count.**

7. ELIGIBILITY OF VEHICLES

For the purpose of safety, all vehicles will comply with General Requirements for Cars and Drivers, Schedules A and B of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. Vehicle categories are as per the official entry form.

For the purpose of records, all vehicles will compete in classes laid out in General Requirements for Cars and Drivers, Classification of Automobiles, with the exception of the Road Registered Class.

Road registered vehicles are defined as vehicles that do not hold CAMS log books, and are currently registered by a State or Territory within Australia. To be eligible for this class, vehicles must comply with requirements listed in the 2014 Hillclimb Series Regulations. **Current registration papers must be produced to be eligible.**

Organisers have the final decision regarding the class cars compete in.

Except for an administration fee of \$25-00 (which will be retained in cases a. and b. below), the entry fee will

Non-production of relevant documentation may entail forfeiture of entry fee and permission to compete may be withdrawn.

Competitors are reminded that if they compete in a vehicle that has a log book, that log book must be presented during the scrutiny process as per Schedule L of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions.

8. RUNNING ORDER

Will be as per the program posted on the Official Notice Board on the day and will be as per the category class form. **Any competitor not ready to compete in program order may miss their run.**

Results will be determined by point scoring. See the 2014 Collingrove Hillclimb Series Regulations for further details.

9. ANIMALS

No animals, other than registered companion and guide (sight & hearing) dogs, be allowed within the hill climb property at all times. Any exceptions can only be authorised by the Clerk of Course.

10. SCRUTINY

Scrutiny will be done in any order AFTER documentation has been checked. Drivers' apparel, including helmet, is to be as per Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and must be presented to the scrutineers for inspection.

All vehicles must be fitted with a fire extinguisher as per Schedule H of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

Any vehicle which, after approval, is dismantled or modified in any way which may affect the safety of the vehicle or raise questions as to its eligibility, or is involved in an accident having similar results, must be submitted for re-scrutiny. Any vehicle leaving the pit or paddock area may also be subject to re-scrutiny. Any car or driver may be prohibited from the event for safety reasons. No competitor will be permitted to compete with exposed limbs.

11. DOCUMENTATION

Documentation will be done in any order BUT BEFORE scrutiny. Drivers must present the following to the officials in the Documentation Office prior to scrutiny –

- Current CAMS Licence
- Current CAMS affiliated Club Membership
- CAMS Log book and COD if issued

Please have these out ready for inspection

12. PARADES, DEMONSTRATIONS, PROMOTIONAL RIDES

Will be conducted at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course. Invited cars may participate in Parade Runs, which will be conducted under the NCR 20A and 20B.

Meeting rides may be conducted and if so, will be conducted in accordance with CAMS Race Meeting Standard Regulations, except that the Car and driver are not required to be otherwise entered in the event. Briefings will be held where necessary and the relevant indemnities signed by all participants.

13. WASTE LIQUIDS

Oil or other waste must **NOT** be disposed of on site. **PLEASE LEAVE THE AREA CLEAN AND TIDY.**

14. FUEL

Is not available on the property. Refuelling of vehicles is to be carried out on the burn out pad. Fuel must comply with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

15. RAISING OF VEHICLES

Changing of wheels and/or any other work that requires vehicles to be raised, non compressible jacks and/or stands must be carried out in the scrutiny carport or the burn out pad.

16. PROTESTS

Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

17. CANCELLATION & POSTPONEMENT

The Organisers reserve the right (in accordance with NRC 59 of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport) to abandon or postpone the event, or any portion thereof, at any time owing to inclement weather or any other unforeseen circumstance.

Notification of **change** of the events status will be posted on the Sporting Car Club website; www.sportingcarclubsa.org.au, at 6pm on the evening prior to the event.

18. USE OF PROHIBITED SUBSTANCES

During any event, consumption of alcoholic beverages in the paddock, pits or any other portion of the competition venue under the control of the officials is expressly forbidden until all practice or competition activity is concluded for each day. Any driver or crew member who is found to be affected by alcohol on the day of the event or practice therefore shall not be permitted to participate. Refer NCR 145A and 145B of the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. In addition, the persons concerned will be subject to the articles of the Standard Operating Procedure for Alcohol Testing, the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy. Competitors, crews or officials may be randomly tested for alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) or other drugs at any time during the event(s). **Other Prohibited Substances:** the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy, as appears in the CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, and as amended from time to time, recognised as an integral component of the NCR and is duly authorised as such. In any areas where the National Competition Rules and the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy conflict, the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy will apply. Additionally, in any areas where the National Competition Rules and the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy conflict, the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy will apply.

19. RE RUNS

Re runs shall not be less than five minutes from the last run. See Item 10 of the 2014 Club Hillclimb Series Regulations for more details.

20. TYRE WARMING

Each driver is allowed one burnout sequence in a single continuous forward motion. A second burnout may be permitted at the discretion of the Clerk of the Course if a delay occurs which is not the fault of the driver. Such second burn out will be conducted at the start line under instructions from the Starter.

21. DRIVER BRIEFING

Attendance is compulsory and failure for Drivers to **SIGN ON** and be present for the duration of the Drivers' Briefing, a penalty will be applied by the Stewards as per Part XI Appendix 185 of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport, and may be varied by the Stewards of the meeting in exceptional circumstances.

Drivers briefing will be held next to the scrutiny bay. For times refer above and attached schedule.
