1. EVENT STANDING

This Event is a Multi-Club Hillclimb and forms part of the Collingrove Challenge Trophy Series.

The Event will be on Sunday 8th April 2018.

The Event will be held at Collingrove Hillclimb, Hillclimb Road, Mt McKenzie 5355 (8 kms from Angaston on the Eden Valley Road).

The Hillclimb is a bitumen sealed surface course, approximately 685 metres long and 3.3 metres wide.

A SPEED LIMIT OF 10 KM/H APPLIES ON THE RETURN ROAD AND IN THE PADDOCK AREA.

3. ENTRIES

Entries open with the publication of these Supplementary Regulations. Entries must be made using www.meecamsau.com or on the prescribed Entry Form and sent with payment to the Events Manager, Sporting Car Club of South Australia, 51 King William Road, Unley.

All entries received at the Sporting Car Club before the closing date of **4:00pm on Wednesday 28th March** will pay an entry Fee **below**

\$100.00 for SCC Club Members

\$125.00 for Non SCC Members

Level 2S-Junior (aged 14-17) Licence holders \$70.00.

Collingrove Improvement Fund Levy (Payable by all competitors) \$ 10.00.

Please note all Entry Fees are GST inclusive.

A CAMS L2S(J) Licence or higher is the required CAMS Licence.

Except for an administration fee of \$25-00 (which will be retained in cases a. and b. below), the entry fee will not be refundable except:

a. In case of the abandonment of the meeting.

b. Where the entry is withdrawn by written advice to the Secretary of the Meeting by the fifth day prior to the event/meeting.

c. Where an entry is refused.

Entries will be limited to 120 and shall be accepted in order of receipt. **No late entries will be accepted.**

Entries may be refused in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

The entry of multiple vehicles and multiple Drivers can be accepted at the sole discretion of the Organisers under the following conditions:

- a. An additional Entry Form must be raised for each entry combination.
- b. A separate entry fee is payable for each entry

4. PRACTICE

There will be no practice for this event. **All runs count.**

5. RUNNING ORDER

The running order will follow as closely as possible the order listed in the Official Running Sheet. Categories will be grouped for each timed run as far as possible. In the case of multiple entered vehicles, the running order will be configured and managed to ensure that each run or re-run for a particular vehicle is separated by a period of not less than five minutes, irrespective of which Driver is in the vehicle.

6. SCRUTINY

Scrutiny will be conducted in the Competitors Paddock/Parking area and only AFTER documentation has been checked.

Drivers' apparel, including helmet, is to be as per Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport and must be presented to the Scrutineers for inspection.

All vehicles must be fitted with a fire extinguisher as per Schedule H of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. Any vehicle which, after approval, is dismantled or modified in any way which may affect the safety of the vehicle or raise questions as to its eligibility, or is involved in an accident having similar results, must be submitted for Re-Scrutiny. Any vehicle leaving the paddock area may also be subject to Re-Scrutiny. Any vehicle or Driver may be prohibited from the Event for safety reasons. No Competitor will be permitted to compete with exposed limbs.

7. DOCUMENTATION

Documentation will be done in any order BUT BEFORE scrutiny. Drivers must present the following to the officials in the Documentation Office prior to Scrutiny –

- Current CAMS Licence
- Current CAMS affiliated Club Membership
- CAMS Log Book and COD if issued
- Proof of registration for road registered vehicles

Please have these out ready for inspection

Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

13. ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.
