

NOTICE TO ALL OWNERS OF HISTORIC VEHICLES ON CLUB REGISTRATION

LATE SUBSCRIPTION PAYMENTS AND LOG BOOKS

Is your subscription for club membership year 2023 overdue?

- if so, please pay as soon as possible,
- after March 1, 2023, the list of unfinancial members will to be sent to Dept of Infrastructure and Transport for Club Registration determination.

Clause 3.10 of the code of practice says: “if a vehicle owner ceases to be a financial member of a recognised motor vehicle club at any time during which the vehicle is registered, the owner must not drive the vehicle or allow any other person to drive the vehicle until such time that the vehicle owner is again a financial member of a recognised motor vehicle club or has taken out standard registration.”

IF MAKING A LATE PAYMENT YOUR LOG BOOK(S) WILL NEED ATTENTION

Please check the front cover for the “Replace Log Book” date (in red ink).

If the date is 31/12/22, you must apply for a new log book with your subscription payment, the following details for each book are required:-

- log book request, name, postal address, vehicle registration number and its expiry date,
- please include the extra payments for each log book (\$5) and return postage (\$1.20 per stamp) if by mail.

If the date is 31/12/23 or 31/12/24, endorsement of your current log book is required, along with your subscription payment, please ensure the following are included:-

- the log book(s) for validation and return postage (\$1.20 per stamp) if by mail,

TO APPLY FOR CLUB REGISTRATION OF HISTORIC VEHICLES

Open hours for the club rooms are from 10 am to 12 noon on the second and fourth Saturday morning of the month from January to September and every Saturday morning from October 14 to December 9, 2023.

Note: a change in the Code of Practice now allows club committees to establish **Validation Persons**. The committee has nominated Berry Treffers, Bev Waters, Alan Cardnell and Tim Johnson to this role and they can sign and stamp your log book (for the membership years) **provided** that you show proof that you are a financial member of the club for the relevant year. For member applying for a new or replacement log book, the rules have not changed; only the club’s authorised persons (club inspectors) are allowed to issue log books.
