The Sprite Car Club of SA has challenged the MGCC(SA) to a (slot car) race!

When – 16 July 23 from 1000

Where – Scalex World Raceway, 3 Paul St, Ridgehaven

Cost - \$20 per person (includes a car, a controller and track hire)

Practice starts at 1000 with the main racing starting at 1100 and running through to 1300 or 1330

If the weather is nice, bring a BYO BBQ lunch and come and burn a sausage in the park across the road from the event or if its miserable we will adjourn to a local pub!

The main event will be a 'Le Mans' style slot car race, with up to six teams of four drivers racing identical 1:24 Bugeye Sprites on the main track over a 24 minute event. Each driver races for 6 minutes, the other three team members helping to keep their car on the track and the greatest number of laps wins the race.



These are not your average Scalextric car. Each Bugeye has been hand built with steel racing chassis. No driver aids, just pure hand-eye coordination!

Clive will have three tracks running, two for practice and the main track for the feature race!
