

## British Classics Tour 2024

Registrations are now open for one of the events coming up to commemorate 100 years of MGs, the British Classics Tour 2024 – an event in its 12th year, finishing up in Victor Harbor which many of our members are already familiar with.

Details are:

**Date:** Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> March

**Start venue:** Port Noarlunga Sporting Complex, Britain Drive, Port Noarlunga

**Time:** Start venue open from 8.00am; check in from 8.30am

**Finish:** Warland Reserve, Victor Harbor

A tasty breakfast will be available at the starting point including the all-important coffee. The route has been carefully selected by Steve Spong and Ken Burke and takes you through about 100km of the most scenic parts of the Fleurieu Peninsula to finish up at Warland Reserve, Victor Harbor.

At Victor there will be complementary scones, jam and cream and a cup of tea (it's a very British event) and every car is automatically entered in the Shannons Show 'n' Shine with trophies in seven classes. These are:

1. Best British Presented Vehicle
2. Best British Classic Commercial Vehicle
3. Best British Classic Motorcycle
4. Best British Classic Family Car
5. Best British Convertible
6. Most Collectable British Classic Vehicle
7. People's Choice from Collectable Cars and Bikes.

A metal car badge has been designed and crafted to recognise the commemorative event and is available for the first 40 'early bird' registrants for just \$27.00, a saving of \$8 on the full price on the day. Registration and entry is just \$30/car, regardless of how many people are in it.

While the event is open to all British marques, in 2024 it's very much an MG day and it would be great to see a strong representation from the Club.
