

CLUB REGISTRATION FOR HISTORIC VEHICLES

Our inspection times for Club Registration business are:-

- from **10 am to 12 noon** at 93 Chief Street, Brompton, on the **second and fourth Saturday mornings of the month until October**,
- when annual subscriptions are due, we will meet **every Saturday morning** from the **second Saturday in November to the second Saturday in December** to receive payments and to issue or update log books.

For vehicles **25 years or more in age, from the year of manufacture**, the owner can apply for Club Registration. If a physical inspection is not practical for registering a Historic Vehicle, photographic evidence of the vehicle will suffice.

A log book may be issued with the MR334 form, **provided the SA registration plate number is known**. However, please contact our inspection team after the Service SA Centre has registered your vehicle with the **new expiry date and with any changes to registration plate number**.

If you **buy a vehicle interstate**, a “vehicle identity” inspection (MR29) is required:-

- for vehicles garaged in the metropolitan area, inspection is with the department’s **Vehicle Standards**,
- if garaged in the country, contact your local SA Police,
- we are required to **record the MR29 form number** before we can issue the MR334 form.

Don’t forget to bring your **driver’s licence** as proof of your ID when you attend to sign the MR334 form and please bring **\$5 for each log book** you require.
